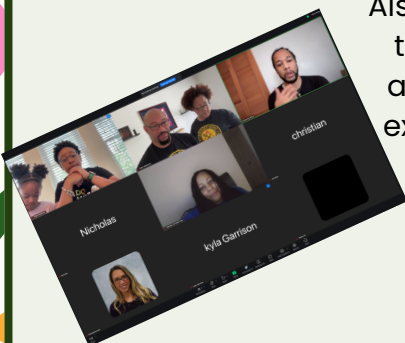
Track Meet Fundraiser

Dr. Dawn Wright was born on April 15, 1961, in Baltimore, Maryland.

Dr. Dawn Wright is an American geographer and oceanographer. She is a leading authority in the application of geographic information system (GIS) technology and she is the first black person, boy or girl, to dive to Challenger Deep, which is in the Marianas Trench in the western Pacific Ocean.
